

Practice Room COVID Guidelines

The Department of Music is committed to keeping you and everyone in our facility safe as we navigate this incredibly difficult time. We cannot do this alone and we require your assistance in maintaining a safe environment for everyone to create music and learn.

We ask that you:

- **Wear a mask** whenever possible, including when you are in a practice room if your instrument allows it.
- Remember the capacity for all practice rooms is **1 person per room**
- Wipe down and sanitize all music stands, keyboard instruments, chairs, and other surfaces touched **before you start practicing** with the sanitation wipes/spray provided.
- When wiping down the piano, **only use peroxide and provided cotton pads, please see the sign on the piano for cleaning instructions**
- Regularly wash your hands for 20 seconds.

Piano Cleaning Procedure

DO NOT CLEAN THE PIANO UNLESS YOU HAVE BEEN PROPERLY TRAINED!

- Dampen a cotton pad with hydrogen peroxide and use the pad to wipe down the piano keytops, back to front.
- Put the disinfectant on the pad, not on the piano.
- Always follow up with a dry towel. Never leave any liquids on the piano or keys.
