All rooms are equipped with the following cleaning supplies:

- Peroxide for cleaning the piano
- Cotton pads for cleaning the piano
- Alcohol solution for cleaning chairs, stands, etc
- Paper towels for wiping down surfaces

When in a room please:

- Wipe down all chairs, stands, and surfaces touched with provided paper towels and spray bottle.

## Piano Cleaning and Usage Procedure Please do not clean the piano without proper training

- Before touching the piano, please wash your hands thoroughly for 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer.
- Dampen a cotton pad with hydrogen peroxide and use the pad to wipe down the piano keytops, back to front. **ONLY USE PEROXIDE TO CLEAN THE PIANO KEYS!**
- Put the disinfectant on the pad, not on the piano keys.
- Always follow up with a dry towel. Never leave any liquids on the piano or keys.
